October is the Month of the Holy Rosary

Pray the Rosary together as a family!

The recitation of the Rosary in the family captures something of the spiritual atmosphere of the household at Nazareth,

"because its members place Jesus at the centre, they share his joys and sorrows, they

place their needs and their plans in his hands, they draw from him the hope and the strength to go on" (n. 41). There, in fact, as Paul VI said on his pilgrimage to Nazareth, one learns "to be resolute in good thoughts, focused on the interior life and ready to understand clearly the secret inspirations of God and the exhortations of the true teachers" (*Insegnamenti di Paolo VI*, II, 1964, p. 24).



Understanding the Scriptures

"My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?" Today's Gospel parable is unsettling in several ways. The various images of rejection, mistreatment, and violence paint an unpleasant picture.

Guests refuse to come to a feast, servants are killed, troops are dispatched. The King continues to try to fill his dinner hall, and then when someone finally does show up, the King throws him out for wearing the wrong clothes. What is going on here?

The message would have been a poignant one for his Jewish listeners. As the chosen people, they were the first to receive the "invitation" to share in the kingdom of God. But the chief priests and elders were uninterested in accepting Jesus and his authority; thus they didn't show up for the feast. But what about those who did come?

Something is expected of them as well. Donning a "wedding garment" is like being properly prepared to enter God's kingdom. Just showing up isn't enough. Here it's important to pay attention to the details. The King first calls his poorly dressed guest, "friend." The approach begins with mercy and kindness. But the man gives no defense for himself, and displays no desire to change. It's as if he doesn't really care to be there at all. The question this raises for us is whether or not we are "dressed" appropriately. We may hang around the banquet hall--going to church, professing to be Christian--but are we sincere guests of the King of kings? Do we truly accept Christ's teachings and live by them, or are we just showing up? The splendors of the invitation Christ gives us should not be taken for granted. We are called to share in a royal feast. May we all be grateful guests. *Taken by LPI, Inc.*

ST MARY "ALL SOULS" REMEMBRANCES

In November, St. Mary will remember all souls in following ways:

Special Remembrance Mass

This year's annual Remembrance Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, November 2nd, at 7:00pm. Parishioners who have died since last November 2nd, will automatically be included. *In addition, all parishioners are invited to contact the parish office and give us the names of any loved ones, from elsewhere, who have died this past year, too.* At that Mass, we will read aloud the names of all of these, and one family member will be able to place a flower in a vase before the altar as their loved one's name is read. *If you would like to include someone, please contact the parish office, as soon as possible.* (To be included on the poster of names that is in the Gathering Space throughout the month, **we must have the name no later than October 23rd** (but you can still be included in the flower remembrance at Mass, after that date). Please call/email the parish office, either way.

Parish Remembrance Book

Our Remembrance Book is in place in the Gathering Space. We invite you to list there the names of your deceased loved ones who died this year, whether from St. Mary, or not. Every person listed will be especially remembered in the intentions at all the Masses celebrated during the month of November, at St. Mary.

All Souls: General Intercessions

Those loved ones listed on our All Souls envelopes are traditionally remembered throughout the month, in our intentions. This will remain so. *However, additionally, beginning this year,* the names of those listed on these envelopes, will be read in the General Intercessions at each Mass, a few at a time. Due to large number of names we anticipate, we will not be able to tell you exactly which Mass your loved one's name will be said, but you will know that sometime in the month, at either a daily or Sunday Mass, their name will be said aloud in the General Intercessions.

Veteran's Mass

Also, we will be having a special Veteran's Mass on Friday, November 10th at 7:00pm in the Church in honor of our living Veterans, those Veterans who are deceased, killed or missing in action. **If you have someone who you would like to honor, please contact the Parish Office by Friday, November 3rd.**

Sacrament of Baptism: Celebrated any Sunday of the month at the 11:30am Mass during the Easter Season, and on the 3rd Sunday at 12:30pm all year round. Parents are required to attend a preparatory session. Please make arrangements in advance through the Parish Office.

Visitation & Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if a family member is seriously ill, facing/recovering from surgery and would like to see a priest or receive the Anointing of the Sick. Holy Communion is also available to those who are homebound.

Marriage: Couples planning to marry will attend a marriage preparation program. Please contact the Parish Office one year in advance of the wedding date.

Funerals: The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. The Mass is the greatest prayer of the Church.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA): The RCIA is a process of formation for full initiation into the Catholic Church. It is open to those never baptized, those baptized in another faith, and Catholics who have not received First Communion and Confirmation. 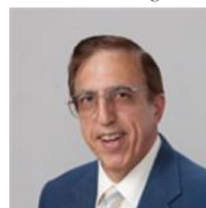
