





A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioner,

Recently, we met with Rod Herrera, who is the Director of the Office of Youth and Child Protection for the Diocese of Camden. Every four years, St. Mary is required to undergo an onsite audit for the Safe Environment Program. I have great news to share in that we are in compliance in everything that was asked of us. I have very happy with that news.

Half way through the meeting, Rod turned to me and said that Sharon Richards (Safe Environment Coordinator for St. Mary) was doing a great job with keeping the parish in compliance. My response was that we know she is doing a great job, but it meant so much to hear it from the Director. Having a safe environment is a top priority of the Diocese and a high priority for us. We never want to see our children harmed in any way.

Rod says that Sharon understands the importance of protecting our children. Sharon cannot do this job on her own. She had a lot of help, in particular, Kathleen Rando, Valerie Mc Donald, Pat Galie, and Megan Sullivan. Valerie and Pat have also incorporated the Child Lures Prevention program, "Think First and Stay Safe", a Diocesan mandated program, into the classroom. But, they all have assisted in making sure that their volunteers are in compliance. {Each volunteer has been fingerprinted and has received a background check. Their clearance letters are kept on file. Each volunteer is also required to attend a CAP session (Child Assault Prevention) once every 5 years. The CAP program is a very informative program and trains the volunteers to be observant and pick things up.}

For the most part, our volunteers have been very good at responding to our requests. However, there have been times we have had to keep asking them to go to the CAP training, as well as in other areas of compliance. We ask that everyone respond in a timely matter!

Rod also took a look at our bulletins to see if the proper information is put in each month. He was so impressed with them, he asked, "Who does our bulletins?" The meeting we had was affirming for everyone. Let us as a parish continue to be vigilant in this area.
