### **G.I.F.T.’s November Book Discussion**

*The GIFT Sponsored Book Discussion Group has selected the following book for our next session.*

***“What Are We Doing On Earth For Christ’s Sake”?*** by Richard Leonard, S.J., a best selling author. This is Father Leonard’s third book in a series of questions.
