Advent: A Season of Waiting?????



Oh my gosh, if there is anything that seems to be universally loathed, it's waiting!

We hate to wait in line at the checkout counter, or wait on "hold" on the phone, or wait for a repairman... the list goes on and on. So, how can we possibly look forward to a whole season of "waiting"?

Well, I guess that depends largely on what we are waiting for. Christmas preparation has become so jam packed with hundreds more tasks added to our already over-burdened "to do" list, I'd be willing to bet that many adults cannot "wait" for all the hubbub to be over. Oh, we (hopefully) enjoy the feast itself but getting there? Well, that's another story.

But, I also suspect that deep down most of us do, in fact, long for the quiet reflection Advent calls us to. Perhaps, this year, we can allow God to "gift" us with a real Advent. He will, you know, if we let it happen. Maybe we might actually discover Advent as a joyful season of "anticipation" in the midst of all the craziness. How?

We eagerly "wait" for the birth of a child in our families, the return of a loved one, a wedding day, and so much more. Let's try to incorporate that kind of "joyful waiting", at least into our thinking, this year.

It could be as simple as making an extra effort to "notice and participate" in the Advent wreath lighting at Mass, each weekend. (Or, perhaps, we can incorporate an Advent wreath into our home preparations, if we don't already) and carry that prayer throughout each week. Then, whether we racing around in our cars, on a moment's break at home/work, or even in the shower, ... we can mentally recall that candle's prayer and a thought of hope, of peace, of joy, and eagerness can fill our hearts, and re-focus us on Christ.

This year, we could take that small step to allow Advent to **be** Advent, in our hearts.

As each candle is lighted, let's pray for:

HOPE: "Center us, Lord, for our hope is in you." (John 3:16-17)

PEACE: "Calm our minds and hearts, Lord, as in this troubled world, we place our trust in you." (Matthew 6:25-34)

INNER CONVERSION: "Change us, Lord, by the remembrance of your birth, that we may more fully **become** your presence now in our world now. Make us instruments of the change we need in our world." (John 15:5-6, 8-17)

JOY: Lord, help us to see your **miraculous presence** in every birth, in every day's new dawn, in those you give us to love, in all those you bring into our lives. (Matthew 13:16-17)

It takes but a moment each day, anytime, anywhere. Instead of dreading the "countdown" of remaining shopping days, maybe we can focus on "drawing near" to the source of life, of hope, of joy, of meaning, of love itself – Jesus, the Christ, whose birth we remember; who comes into our lives each day; whose coming in glory we **joyfully await**. Happy Advent, everyone!
