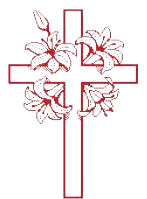

## From the Pastor

Dear Parishioner,

Most of you have heard by now that I have been named Pastor of St. Thomas in Brigantine. The effective date is July 1, 2017. I will be starting Fourth of July weekend. Quite a weekend to break in at the shore! This will be the fourteenth time I have moved in my life.

My assignment at St. Mary's has been a good one. I am very grateful to Bishop Galante for asking me to be pastor here. I have looked upon this Pastorate as a makeup for something that had happened earlier in my Priesthood. This is a correction in many ways. I have never questioned that I was fortunate to be here. I have learned so much from you. I will try to bring some of that to Brigantine.

I have had two goals during my time here. One personal, and that is to become more God-like. The other one is for St. Mary to continue as a fully, active parish. Both of these goals were achieved! We will remain fully a parish. A new pastor will be coming.

I am very grateful for our staff here. They do so much. So, it freed me to be the contemplative that I am. I need to spend huge periods of time each day in prayer, meditation, and homily preparation. This is not a daily chore. It is a daily passion! I cannot function properly without spending long periods of time with the Lord. It makes me a more effective priest!

I have given over 2,500 homilies during my time here. I always try to come up with something new each time. I now find myself struggling to come up with new material. I do not like being repetitive. It will be good for you to hear a new voice.

Change is always difficult! Some aspects of the parish will be considerably better! Others will not be as good as there are always tradeoffs. Each new pastor offers new ways of being a parish. Each new pastoral assignment offers new ways of being a priest.

I am sorry, but I will not be able to come back for funerals. I was frequently asked to come back to my last parish my first two years here. I got myself in trouble with the Diocese for it. It certainly is not fair to the new pastor! Plus, I am going to be very busy in Brigantine. I am not going for semi-retirement. This will probably be my last Pastorate and I want to do something big for the Lord. He has been so good to me!

I have deeply appreciated the support you have given me these seven years. Especially, the very kind words that you have said to me in the last month. May God continue to bless you in every way.

## Gospel Meditation

"Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, 'Peace be with you.'" Then, he said it again. And then, "he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'" Jesus brings peace, and he brings the Holy Spirit. Peace, in fact, is one of the fruits of the Holy Spirit. Today, on this feast of Pentecost, we remember the dramatic outpouring of the Holy Spirit that came upon those first apostles and the peace that came along with it. But, we do more than remember. We also celebrate the presence of this same Spirit in our midst.

Through the sacrament of Baptism, every Christian receives the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit in his or her soul.

Thus, the gift of peace is already ours! The question is whether or not we have really begun to appreciate and utilize this most precious gift. Like the apostles who had locked themselves up "for fear of the Jews," we, too, are capable of imprisoning ourselves in our own anxieties. We fret and worry about the future, about our sufferings or our disappointments, and too often let these concerns stifle the true peace that Jesus offers us.

But the Church today urges us to rejoice and to step out in faith like the apostles who left their fears behind them.

Peace not only alleviates our fears, it also frees us to live our faith to the fullest, to have the courage to take risks, and to leave our comfort zone for the sake of the Gospel. This is what we are called and, not only that, empowered to do.

Anything less is a kind of spiritual poverty we bring upon ourselves. God has given us the gift of himself, present and available in every moment, every place, and every situation. May we recognize this most wonderful gift and give thanks with grateful hearts. *(Taken from LPI, Inc.)*

#### Why do we stand for the Gospel?

While sitting is a position of receptivity for the other two readings, we stand for the Gospel in joyful anticipation of hearing the Good News of Jesus.

It is also a sign of respect for the words of Jesus and to manifest an eagerness and attentiveness to hear his Word. This makes sense if we consider our everyday experience of greeting a guest. If we are eager to meet someone important who is about to enter the room, we would stand out of respect. In the same way, we stand to greet Christ and to anticipate the proclamation of his Good News.

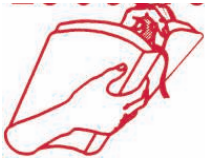
