

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

July is traditionally the slowest month in Parishes. That was not the case here this year. We had 2 weeks of a Summer Intensive Religious Education program plus our usual Vacation Bible School week.

Twenty three parishes now have a summer program. The Diocese has been stressing it. We have the children for three hours a day for two weeks. That's a total of thirty hours, as many as they would have for the traditional program. We are well aware of our families' busy schedules and we have tried to adjust to that. Families now have the option of either the Summer Intensive Religious Education program or the traditional Religious Education program. As long as I am Pastor here, we will have both of them.

There are advantages and disadvantages to both programs. All the levels were full except for the First Level. It was a great success! Those in the Summer Program will also participate in at least six intergenerational events during the year.

My biggest concern was, "would we be able to get the Catechists in the summer?" Valerie Mc Donald and Pat Galie did a terrific job getting very good teachers and organizing the program. I was over every day and it looked as if we had been doing it for years.

Special thanks to Valerie Mc Donald for her role as Coordinator for our annual Vacation Bible School. As usual, it was well done! We are fortunate to have some one so dedicated and talented. May God bless her!

Our traditional program will begin in September. We can always use good Catechists and aides. Please think about helping us to spread the Good News. Our children's Religious Education is a top priority for us.

There was a good amount of work done here in the spring. Three blocks of concrete in front of the church were being lifted up by tree large roots. It was a danger! Our landscapers, Merit, were able to break up the concrete and put down new concrete. It is now much easier for those who have wheelchairs or walkers. We also were able to remove the discoloration from the outside walls of the classrooms, as well as much of the Parish Hall. It was a real eyesore. The Sanctuary wood floors have been sanded and re-finished. It was drab and now it is much brighter.

Last fall, we had a new furnace put into the Parish Center. It was old and broken down and needed to be replaced. These are just some of the things that have been done this past year. We are well aware that much more needs to be done! Tom Wakeley has been involved in all of our projects and has been a tremendous help.

Changing the subject to St. Mary giving, we not only made our House of Charity goal, but we exceeded it. I am so happy that as a Parish, we take great pride in making our goal and helping our brothers and sisters in South Jersey. We also received back \$19,000 for our own needs here. This is a win-win situation for everyone.

On a sadder note, we have lost well over 50 practicing Catholics through death and those moving out of the state. Those who have died are now completely serene. They are having a great time! We are happy for them. But, we do miss them and all the great things they did. I keep telling myself that God will provide. But, I am concerned about losing so many. That is a trend that will continue. On a positive note, we are getting new parishioners registering. We also continue to get calls for baptisms. We love the newborn infants!

On October 9th-11th of this year, we are going to have a tremendous mission at St. Mary. It will be given by Rev. William Garrott, OP. I want to use this as a way to evangelize. Please invite people to these graced filled days.

Lastly, I want to thank you for all the great things you do here. It is very impressive! But, I think we can all do a better job of getting the word out to others about how good a parish this is! We want our parish family to continue to grow.
