## ST. MARY'S BLOOD DRIVE IS THIS WEEK AND WE NEED YOUR DONATION!

The Drive is scheduled between 9:30AM and 7:30PM this coming Thursday, September 29, in our Parish Hall, and we need additional donors. Remember, there is no other way to be able to provide a blood transfusion to someone who needs it, than to share through this donation process. The primary use of blood today is for cancer patients, many of them young children, who are undergoing chemotherapy.

A person now needs to be only 16 years of age (with parental consent, but no longer required if at least 17 years of age), be in relatively good health and weigh at least 110 pounds to be eligible to donate. Any regular blood donation you may have made after August 4 (June 9 for Double Red Donations) makes you ineligible to donate at this September drive. With some recent changes that allow you to complete the registration process via computer before you arrive at the Drive, it should take as little as 45 minutes of your time to give the gift of life.

In order to maintain an orderly flow and speed the donation process, we ask that you register for an appointment time. Because this is the last weekend for sign-ups, please stop at the sign-up table in the Gathering Space after Mass today, or make a phone call as soon as you get home to Ron Von Stetina at 856-424-3051.

## "To comfort those who mourn"

Who among us has not known the need of a reassuring hand or hug, or word of comfort when a loved one dies. We each have experienced the strength and healing that comes from such an encounter.

Here at St. Mary, our bereavement ministers reach out to those in grief to extend that consolation; to help them put the funeral Mass "pieces" (readings, music, ministers) in place.... And, when needed, to follow up with our parish's extended support...

Presently, we have on 2 ministers who meet with the family when the call comes in that a parishioner has died. We have only 4 ministers able to alternately serve as Altar Servers, at the funeral Mass. And, only 1 who is able to do a follow-up phone call.

Would you consider becoming an instrument of Christ's strength and consolation to those in need? Would you be willing to do any component of this Ministry? Training would be provided by those already serving.

Please consider this opportunity? St. Mary averages about 30 funerals a year... so we really do need additional ministers to care for those experiencing loss in our midst.
