Steward's Provide Peace

"Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace to you.' But they were startled and frightened." LUKE 24:36-37A

Throughout the day, we have many opportunities to be good **Stewards** and "see the face of Jesus" in others and provide some "peace" in their lives. Just because the person is a stranger, maybe looks different than us, or is someone we don't particularly care for doesn't let us off the hook.



Peace be with you!

"He stood in their midst and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' But they were startled and terrified." What was so terrifying about being wished peace? How ironic that the disciples were so scared right at the moment that Jesus was offering them peace.

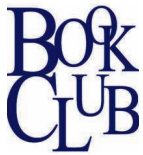
The fact is that they didn't understand what was going on. They were already aware at this point that Jesus had risen from the dead, and two of them had just had a powerful encounter with him on the road to Emmaus.

But now, he suddenly appeared before them, in a manner that was not only totally unexpected, but also apparently physically impossible. This is why they thought they were seeing a ghost. It just didn't make sense.

Jesus reassured them with concrete actions. He told them to look at him and to touch him. He wanted his disciples to be comforted by his real physical presence among them. He wanted them to come into contact with his entire being, not just the abstract idea of his presence. Once they did this, they were "incredulous for joy and were amazed." The peace that he wished for them was now complemented by great joy. It just took a while to sink in.

This may be the case for us at times too. We may not understand the mysterious ways in which Jesus is present in our lives. Sometimes he is hidden in what Mother Teresa called "the distressing disguise." His Spirit may be present, wishing to bring us peace right in the midst of stress, sickness, anguish, or pain, but we may not recognize him at first. But just because he may not "show up" in the way we expect doesn't mean he isn't with us. The risen Christ also wants to give us the gift of peace.

Did you think about it even when you weren't reading it?

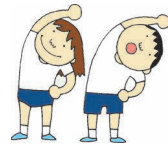
Did you tell your friends what a great read it was and they should read it as well?

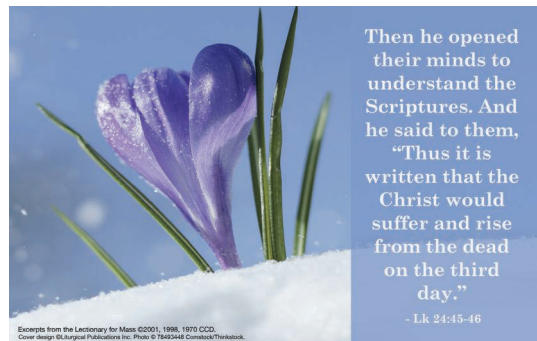

Celiac Disease and Holy Communion

*Celiac Disease and some Thyroid conditions can make receiving communion for some people extremely difficult, if not impossible. St. Mary now has a **limited amount of Low Gluten hosts**, already consecrated, in the tabernacle at Mass, each weekend. These hosts, made by the Benedictine Sisters contain an infinitesimal amount of gluten (.002) and, have been shown, generally, to not affect those suffering from these conditions. If you **need** low gluten hosts, please:*

- *Be seated in the section of pews on the Window Aisle, on the left side: (near the Icon of Mary).*
- *Try to be near the front of the Communion line, and just say "low gluten" to the Communion Minister, before receiving.*

*Our supply of consecrated hosts are limited at each celebration so, we ask you to please utilize this opportunity **for medical needs only**. That way, we can ensure having enough for those who absolutely need them. Thank you!*

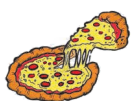
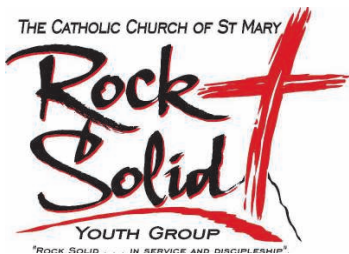
