## THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

"They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him."

Mary Magdalene had stood faithfully beside Jesus – even until he took his last breath on the Cross. She had seen him laid in the tomb and had already gone to his burial place to mourn and grieve over his tragic death. But today, upon her arrival at the tomb, she could not find her Lord. Wasn't it enough to inflict his body with torturous blows and crucify her innocent Lord? Why did they have to steal his body, too? Imagine the despair Mary Magdalene must have felt at that moment. As if the events of

Good Friday had not been enough, now she faced this loss as well. All the signs converged around her making her feel powerless and afraid. Her eyes could only see the darkness of the empty tomb.

Then – in this most horrific moment in time – when no hope remained, just when there seemed to be no possible answer, when everything was far beyond human imagining, Jesus appeared – glorious, victorious and totally unexpected. His triumph over death was also a triumph over human hopelessness and despair. It was proof of God's incredible love; proof of God's omnipotence and power. Proof that God is "bigger than our biggest problem," that he is more powerful than the most threatening evils and fears that lurk in and around our lives.

Today the joy of Easter is ours – today and every day. As Christians, we can rejoice in belonging to a God who is ready and able to break through the toughest barriers of sin and death in our lives and in our world – even when we least expect it. *(Adapted from Liturgical Publications, Inc.)*



What is Divine Mercy? The Divine Mercy Message and Devotion

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us — all of us. And, he wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

This message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread.

Spend time learning more about the mercy of God! Psalm 32:10 .....but mercy surrounds him who trusts in the LORD.

## St. Mary Lighting Update

Let there be light! We are happy to announce that the second phase of the church lighting project is complete. We will now be able to once again properly illuminate the altar area and to turn on all the lights in the

flurorescent fixtures. The original dimmer panel and its controls have been replaced with a simplified system using a new circuit breaker panel and two new banks of switches. One bank consists of dimmer switches which control the spot lights above the altar and the other employs simple switches to operate the fluorescent light fixtures. We have been impressed with the professionalism and flexibility of our electricians from Delgado Electric who worked around several funerals in the last two weeks to complete the project.
