

Funerals: The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. The Mass is the greatest prayer of the Church.



Penitential Disciplines of Lent

The Lenten Fast and Abstinence Regulations are as follows:*Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on (Ash Wednesday) and all the Fridays of Lent. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on (Ash Wednesday) and Good Friday. On (Ash Wednesday) and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other smaller meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
