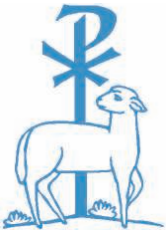

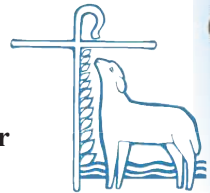

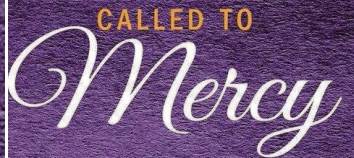
Religious Education - Martin Luther King Day of Service

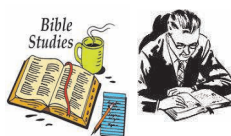
