Daily Mass: Monday-Friday: 8:00am (Chapel)

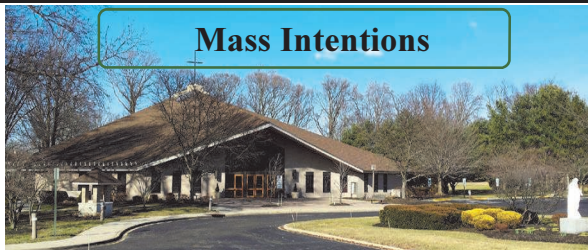
Korean Mass: 5:00pm (Sunday)

Bishop Sullivan invites the faithful of the diocese to join him and his priests for the Chrism Mass at 3:00 P.M. on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at St. Agnes Church/Our Lady of Hope Parish in Blackwood. The Chrism Mass is a celebration of the priesthood and the occasion at which the bishop consecrates the sacred oils used in the sacramental life of the Church. Your presence and prayerful support will be greatly appreciated.

HOLY THURSDAY REMINDER

Don't forget, the collection, at Mass on Holy Thursday, will consist of both food items for the Cherry Hill Food Pantry and monetary donations. Please bring a non-perishable food item with you to benefit those less fortunate.



Good Friday Collection
The Good Friday Collection provides funds to help the Holy Father provide: care for the Holy Places, social & charitable activities, pastoral activities, educational & scientific activities, Liturgy &

Ecumenical activities, & communication activities.

Pope Francis, in keeping with a long standing tradition, has encouraged us to support generously the Good Friday Collection which aids and supports Christians in the Holy Land.

As you know, the wars, unrest, and instability in the Middle East have been especially difficult for Christians who suffer because of their faith. The persecution offers significant challenges to those who minister in the Holy Land. Recently, Father Pierbattista Pizzaballa, Custos of the Holy Land, offered this assessment: "I don't know what the Holy Land will be like in five years but I do know that we will still be there."

Holy Doors of the Camden Diocese

The purpose of a "holy door" is to foster the practice of making a pilgrimage which is symbolic of our journey through life in faith. In his *Bull of Indiction*, Pope Francis reminds us that "anyone who enters the *Door of Mercy* will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope." (*Misericordiae Vultus*, 2-3)

Bishop Sullivan has designated the following as Jubilee Churches, each featuring a Holy Door: Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Camden, Church of Our Lady of Lourdes, Glassboro, Church of St. Nicholas, Atlantic City, Church of Saint Francis of Assisi, Vineland, and Church of Our Lady Star of the Sea, Cape May.

St. JP II, "To focus on the door is to recall the responsibility of every believer to cross its threshold. To pass through that door means to confess that Jesus Christ is Lord; it is to strengthen faith in him in order to live the new life which he has given us. It is a decision which presumes freedom to choose and also the courage to leave something behind, in the knowledge that what is gained is divine life."

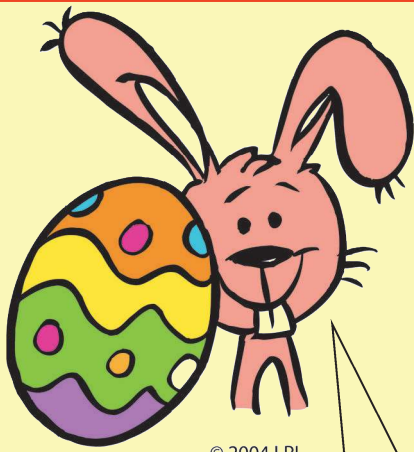
CELEBRATING THE YEAR OF MERCY

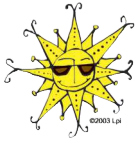

**SUMMER INTENSIVE
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
PROGRAM
COMES TO ST. MARY!**

Beginning this summer, we are offering the option of a Summer Intensive Religious Education Program. Our classes for Levels 1-8 will run for 10 consecutive weekdays from July 11th-22nd from 9:00am to Noon. Completion of all 10 days will fulfill the requirement of classroom instruction for that level. Students in the summer program will still be required to participate in designated activities such as Penance services & Retreats, during the school year.

Our Current (or traditional Program) will still be offered from September through April, for Levels 1-4 on Tuesdays afternoons, Level 8 on Tuesday evenings and Level 5-7 on Tuesday or Wednesday evenings.

Copies of the 2016-2017 Registration Form will also be available in the Office & Gathering Space. The fee schedule is the same for both options. If a student started late to our program and needs a catch-up, this student may want to register for both Summer and Traditional options to complete 2 levels, in one school year.
