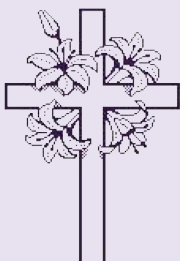

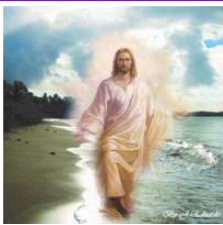
Recognizing God in your Ordinary Moments
