

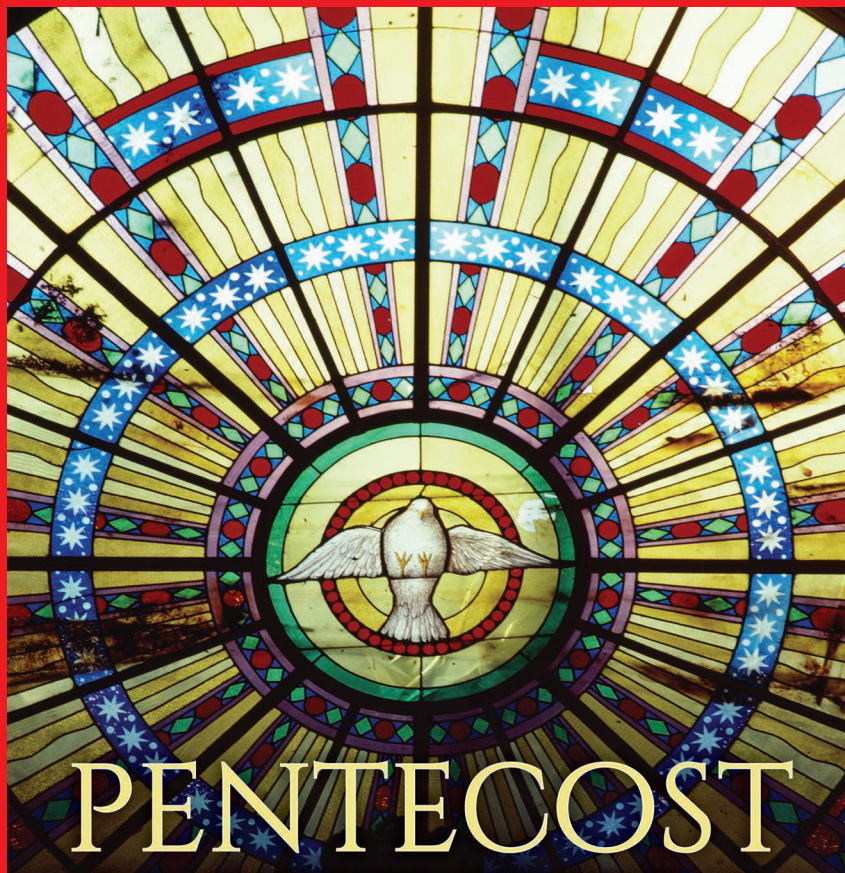

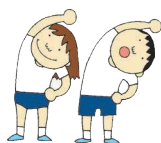
Catholic Charities' Year of the Family newsletter for the month of May is now available online on the agency's Year of the Family website:

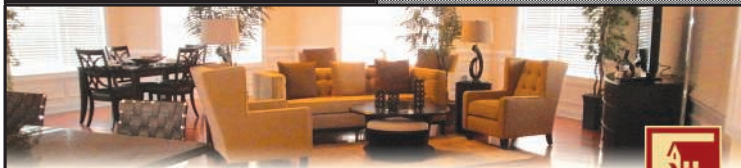
