Why as Catholic Christians during Holy Week do we participate in the tradition of hearing two distinct and seemingly different Gospel Narratives?

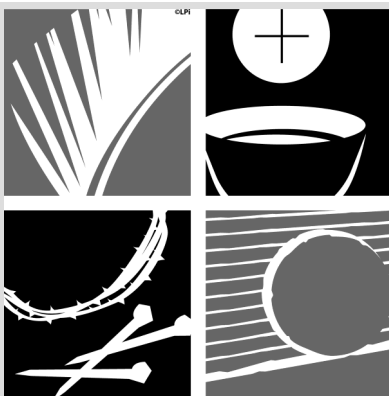
Why the difference? Why do we call Good Friday, Good Friday?

By examining the readings from both Palm Sunday and Good Friday, the Church lets us more fully appreciate the nuances of the Sacred Scripture. In order to prepare for these 2 classes, please preview the readings below:

Palm Sunday: Mk 11:1-10 or Jn 12:12-16/Is 50:4-7/
Ps 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24 [2a]/Phil 2:6-11/Mk 14:1--15:47 or 15:1-39

Good Friday: Is 52:13-53:12/Ps 31:2, 6, 12-13, 15-16, 17, 25 [Lk 23:46]/Heb 4:14-16; 5:7-9/Jn 18:1--19:42

The purpose of this exercise is meant to bring a more holistic understanding of the celebrations on both Palm Sunday, Good Friday, and Easter liturgies.
