


Understanding the Scriptures

Happy Trinity Sunday! In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus declare together all three Persons of the Trinity. "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

When we speak of the Trinity, one theological word is sometimes used: "immanent". The immanent Trinity is

the life of the three Persons within themselves, the inner harmonious relationship between Father, Son, and Spirit. We see this in the Gospels when Jesus speaks of his Father and promises to send the Holy Spirit. Made in the image and likeness of God, we are called to imitate God's immanence by giving and receiving love with one another in community. However, this is not limited only to those close to us, though that's where love often starts. We also imitate... God when we go out... (and) extend our love and care in a life-giving way.

Every believer is sent on mission. Every believer is invited to follow Jesus and the Apostles "to the nations," to the margins, to the people who require a little extra reach. This could be a distant relative, the residents of your local homeless shelter or even the forgotten neighbor next door! When we love well, we create something beautiful-a relationship, a holy moment, a foretaste of heaven. This Trinity Sunday, take some time to examine the relationships in your life. 
Your Son died for our eternal life in heaven. So too, your children died protecting us here on earth.

CAMPAIGN FOR THE CATHOLIC COMMUNITY OF SOUTH JERSEY

LEADERSHIP WEEKEND WILL BE HELD ON JUNE 9th & 10th

During all Masses next weekend, we will invite all families who have not yet been contacted to join us in participating in the **Catholic Strong** campaign. We ask you to consider a sacrificial gift to the campaign – one that is right for you.

70% of funds remain at OUR parish!

Bishop Sullivan has asked each of us to consider a small amount each month over a three-to-five year period. Pledging allows each of us the opportunity to make a sacrificial gift that will help to shape the Church we leave for future generations of Catholic families in our community. The suggested giving plans listed below are an example of how a pledge can have a profound impact on our parish and programs across our diocese.

Our Parish Goal is \$800,000. We will utilize the 70% to address the following needs:

• Replace Parish Hall & Church HVAC/air conditioning system (\$200,000) • Renovate Parish Hall kitchen (\$50,000) • Reupholster Church pews and remove car-

peting to replace with tile (\$140,000) • Replace rectory roof (\$15,000) • Replace roof on Parish Hall (\$90,000) • Hire a full-time Youth/Young Adult & Family minister and provide funding for one year of salary and benefits (\$65,000) - Replace Church Sound System (\$20,000)

Thirty percent (30%) aids enhanced evangelization and new ministries in South Jersey:

- *Strong faith and evangelization programs*
- Strong service ministries in the forms of addiction healing, legal counsel, and assistance to marginalized individuals and families; and finally
- Strong Catholic schools by providing scholarship assistance, professional development, challenging programming, and a strong central office.

Possible Gift Plans (36 months)

\$208 per month over 36 months = \$7,500 \$167 per month over 36 months = \$6,000 \$84 per month over 36 months = \$3,000 \$50 per month over 36 months = \$1,800

Possible Gift Plans (60 months)

\$334 per month over 60 months = \$20,000 \$250 per month over 60 months = \$15,000 \$167 per month over 60 months = \$10,000 \$100 per month over 60 months = \$6,000



Sacrament of Baptism: Celebrated the 3rd Sunday at 12:30pm all year round. During the Easter season, Baptisms may be celebrated any Sunday during the 11:30am Mass. Parents are required to attend a preparatory session. Please make arrangements through the Parish Office.

Visitation & Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if a family member is seriously ill, facing/recovering from surgery and would like to see a priest or receive the Anointing of the Sick. Holy Communion is also available to those who are homebound.

Marriage: Couples planning to marry will attend a marriage preparation program. Please contact the Parish Office one year in advance of the wedding date.

Funerals: The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. The Mass is the greatest prayer of the Church.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA): The RCIA is a process of formation for full initiation into the Catholic Church. It is open to those never baptized, those baptized in another faith, and Catholics who have not received First Communion and Confirmation.
